

Icon Glossary:



Planting: Classes/Groups/Studies with the orange seed icon are designed for people who want to learn more. You may be new to the Christian faith or want to learn more about a particular topic. All are welcome. These classes often meet for one hour.



Nurturing: Classes/Groups/Studies with the blue water icon are designed for people who want to go deeper in a particular topic or with a group of people. The nurturing icon indicates that the class may include light preparation.



Shaping: Classes/Groups/Studies with the green/purple flower icon are designed for people who are ready to make a deeper commitment to their faith. These classes often have preparation and meet more frequently or longer than an hour.



Sharing: Classes/Groups/Studies with the fruit icon are designed for mature Christians. These classes usually have preparation and meet weekly for one to two hours. Often times these groups share leadership roles.




