It's difficult to believe that the Sandra Bullock and George Clooney movie, Gravity, was released nearly four years ago. It was one of those movies that I was not interested in seeing in the theater but rather waited for it to be released on video or Netflix. What I learned was with the beautiful "starscapes" and wonderfully written script, it would have been a wonderful experience on the large screen. Movie Reviewer, Matt Zoller Seitz, wrote:

is about, I'll tell them it's a tense adventure about a space mission gone wrong, but once they've seen and absorbed the movie, they'll know the truth. The root word of "Gravity" is "grave." That's an adjective meaning weighty or glum or substantial, but it's also a noun: the place where we'll all end up eventually. The film is about that moment when you suffered misfortune that seemed unendurable and believed all hope was lost and that you might as well curl up and die, and then you didn't. Why did you decide to keep going? It's

a mystery as great as any in physics or astronomy, and one we've all grappled with, and transcended."

In the month of October, we're offering a Stewardship Study and series of messages based on Pastor Tom Berlin's book, Defying Gravity: Break Free from the Culture of *More.* Stewardship is often viewed as – to use the words of Zoller Seitz – a topic that is "weighty or glum or substantial." While it is true that stewardship is a weighty and substantial topic, we need not necessarily be glum about it. I believe that there can be great joy in living out our lives with compassion, kindness and generosity. But in order to live like that requires us to do just what Berlin suggests by the title of his book: defying gravity and breaking free of the culture of more.

"Defying Gravity" requires us to recognize just what attracts us and why. Pastor Berlin cuts right to the crucial questions surrounding stewardship and generosity. One question he asks in his book is "What is it about money that creates difficulties for Christians?" Ponder that question for a moment.

Perhaps there will be as many reaction to that question as there are people reading these words.

I want to invite you to be part of a study of Berlin's book during the month of October. Beginning on Sunday, October 1, there will be two studies during the first four weeks of October. Sunday evening classes will be at 7:30 p.m. on October 1, 8, 15 and 22 and Tuesday evening classes will be at 7:00 p.m. on October 3, 10, 17 and 24. I will be leading these studies which I pray will bring all of us closer to defying gravity and lead us toward living our lives for God's greatest purposes.

This study and the Sunday morning messages on October 15, 22 and 29 will bring us to our Celebration Sunday (October 29) when our members and friends will be asked to bring their Estimates of Giving during our worship services as a sacrifice of worship. Here's to a gravity-defying October! I look forward to seeing you in worship.
