# Pear Friends,

What a treat this past Sunday (Mother's Day) when our oldest son, Jeremiah, and his wife, Sara, along with our grandson, Liam, spent some time with us through the wonder of "video chatting." Liam was testing out his vocabulary as we chatted with Jeremiah and Sara. He pretty much has "Poppa" perfected while "Oma" sounds a little like "Elmo" and "Uncle Ben" (Spiderman references and retorts welcomed) is not fully recognizable yet.

Of course we would be derelict in our duty as loving parents if we didn't inquire about Sara's condition; number two grandson is on the way – due date in early June. The arrival of a child is an incredible blessing; however, we all know that the birth process is difficult and always painful. Paul mentioned the pain of childbirth in his letter to the Romans (8:22-28).

Paul uses the image of birth pangs, applying that image to creation itself,

then the church and then to our Spirits. Paul is compelled to explain that life is often painful – especially during transitional times of our lives as new life emerges from us, our community and our world.

I am mindful of the pain of transition as so much new life is emerging around us. Rev. Kathy is embarking on a new career as part of our conference leadership. Of course we are experiencing the pain of saying farewell. Our Staff Parrish Relations Committee is involved in finding someone to work in ministries currently lead by Rev. Kathy. A new profile has been created, the job posted and we anxiously await responses to those postings as we ponder our uncertain future. Fear of the unknown future is painful.

We are wading into the deeper waters of our "Creating a Culture of Calling" project begun in January. We've conducted a couple "focus groups" to discern where we are in our ministry together. Part of that discernment

process is discovering what people think and feel, hear, say, do and see as well as determine our "Pains and Gains." Fear of making changes is held in tension with the fear of declining ministries. The anxiety produced by that tension is painful.

While there is anxiety, fear and pain present as we travel through these transitions in our ministry at Central Church, there is much for which we can be thankful. Eight youth joined the church on Mothers' Day as we received this year's Confirmation Class into membership. We are receiving applications for our Director of Lifelong Faith Formation position. We are moving forward with new program ideas as we work on our "Creating a Culture of Calling" project. It is a painful time, it is an anxious time, and it is a wonderful time to be in ministry with you and with our God!

I look forward to seeing you in worship as we celebrate Pentecost – the birth of our church!
