

Pear Friends,

Can you remember the last time your faith got shaken up? For our six confirmation students, each confirmation class during the last year was a time to ask questions, revisit what we know, and explore our faith more and more. Some classes shook us up more than others and I'm not quite sure if, on confirmation Sunday, all the disruption will be settled. To be fair, our faith should always be in a process of shaking and settling. So, rather than ascribe answers to all the confirmands' questions (and there were many) we've learned some new skills to be able to discuss our faith, and what it means for how we live in the world.

In September, we blessed our confirmands and connected them with mentors from our faith community. In addition to coming to class on Sunday nights, confirmands and their mentors were tasked with doing additional activities to explore their faith, like exploring our hymnal and reading scripture. The pairs also did acts of service like baking cookies and sending cards to homebound members.

In January, confirmands visited Micah 6 in Pontiac for a night of service. They helped prepare an apartment for painting in order that a low-income family might have a new place to live. In February, confirmands had an overnight retreat that focused on prayer. We explored different types of prayer that we find in scripture, crafted our own prayers, and looked at prayer traditions from different cultures and faiths.

Now we are nearing confirmation Sunday, where we will welcome these confirmands as full members of our church. They will profess their faith in Jesus Christ and vow to participate in the life of our church.

But they will not be the only ones affirming their faith! As a congregation, we will remember our vow to increase their faith, confirm their hope, and perfect them in love that we pledged to them over the waters of baptism. These young people will need more than their parents and mentors to journey with them as they continue to strengthen their faith and claim it as their own. I hope you'll take some time to consider how you will walk along side these young people—through prayer, through volunteering with our youth programs, through service alongside them, through worshiping with them, and so much more! But I'll warn you now, just when you think you'll be strengthening their faith with your presence, their wisdom and questions will shake up your beliefs and make your faith that much stronger.
