

Pear Friends,

While the summer days are longer and offer to us more time to relax and enjoy warmer weather and outdoor activities, there is much work that has been done and is being done so that Central Church can confidently move into our fall programming. Part of our work this summer was meeting with Cathy Townley of Townley Coaching this past weekend (July 26-28). Cathy is a worship specialist and a Deacon in the United Methodist Church. I have been aware of Cathy's work for over two decades. She is the author of a resource called *Come Celebrate!* that was used as a foundation for starting a new service in the church I was serving in the late 1990's.

Cathy's newest project is Building Worship Bridges, book and workbook, which she co-authored with Congregational Development Director Kay Kotan, Susquehanna District, and Bishop Robert Farr, of the Missouri Annual Conference. The subtitle of Building Worship Bridges is "Accelerating Neighborhood Connections through Worship." Out of Cathy's work in Building Worship Bridges is the concept of discerning the mission field to which we are called to be in ministry with, while offering compassionate ministry to others in our mission area.

Cathy met with our staff on Friday, July 26th and then drove around the area to get a sense of our community and how we might reach out to those living nearest to our church. Cathy mentioned in her time with us Jesus' words as recorded in Acts 1:8, "But you will receive power when the Holy Spirit has come upon you; and you will be my witnesses in Jerusalem, in all Judea and Samaria, and to the ends of the earth." Cathy shared that we start with the people in our neighborhood and then, using the model expressed by Jesus, move outward towards the ends of the earth.

In the months to come, Cathy will be working with our staff and church leadership to create meaningful worship, while reaching out to the surrounding community. I have found her comments insightful as well as challenging. She has challenged me to make personal changes that I know will not be easy to make; however, her words also inspire toward those changes.

As she mentioned to those who took part in the workshop on Saturday, July 27, and the meeting following worship on Sunday, July 28, she will be with us for a long time. What does this mean? For right now, only one thing: prayer. Cathy asked the staff and the participants of the workshop and meeting to do one thing immediately. Pray five minutes a week for our church and our efforts to reach our community for God's purposes. Five minutes a week. Will you join us? Can you find five minutes a week—not necessarily even all at once—to pray for Central Church and our efforts to reach our "Jerusalem, Judea and Samaria to the ends of the earth?" I know you can! I look forward to seeing you in worship.
