This past Sunday I began a three-message series that revisits our Mission Statement at Central Church, which was created in 2015. From time to time our church leadership has looked over our Mission Statement and affirmed it in terms of relevance and integrity for the ministry and mission of our congregation. Now I believe it's time for our church together to consider our Mission Statement as we begin to emerge from the Covid-19 Pandemic within the next few months.

The three messages will focus on the three phrases that make up our Mission Statement: I) Connecting with God, 2) Connecting with Others and 3) Changing our World with Christ's Love. This past All Saints' Sunday we considered what it means to connect with God. As we worshiped with those who have lost loved ones since the last time we observed All Saints' Sunday, I wanted us to consider how we connect with our loving God, who comforts us in our time of need and is present with our loved ones who are no longer by our sides. The Apostle Paul wrote that when we are absent from the body, we are present with the Lord (II Corinthians 5:8).

The scripture we focused on this past Sunday was John 15: 1-8 in which Jesus describes our connection with him as a vine with many branches. Jesus said, "I am the vine, you are the branches." (Verse 5) The implication of Jesus' words is that we are to bear fruit for God's kingdom on earth, and we cannot do that unless we have a healthy connection with God through Jesus the Christ.

That healthy connection is created through pruning. The vine grower (God in this allegory) prunes back those vines which prevent the branches from bearing fruit. Dead vines and leaf-laden branches must be cut away to allow the energy of the vine to produce fruit. I suggested in the message that pruning involves studying the scriptures, being regular in our prayers and worshiping God both privately and with other disciples of Jesus.

Let me conclude this letter with a few questions. What are you doing to grow closer to God? What fruit do you desire to grow for God's kingdom on earth? (Hint: Read Galatians 5:16-26) What strength and guidance do you need from God in order to grow closer to God? Consider these questions and prepare to hear the next two messages as we focus on what it means to connect with others and change our world with Christ's love! I look forward to seeing you in worship.
