Dear Friends,

One of the conversational topics that I find myself engaged in during this past ten months to a year is, "How do we get people back in our sanctuary?" Ever wonder where the term "browbeat" comes from? It originated in the 1580s and means, originally, "to bear down with stern or arrogant looks." I could hardly believe that my colleague could furrow her brow so much as to intimidate her church toward in-person worship attendance. I would prefer not to browbeat or use any other type of intimidation to encourage our membership to show up on Sunday mornings. However, I would be negligent if I didn't tell our members and friends that you are missed. When there are more people gathered together in our sanctuary, there is more joy, more volume in our singing and more opportunities to greet each other more warmly.

I get it. Covid-19 has not and never will leave our world. It is a part of our existence now and is still making some people very ill. That is why I encourage people to care for themselves in whatever way they find necessary to protect themselves and their loved ones. Wear a mask, keep your distance and certainly get your vaccinations. Our online presence will continue, however, I do believe it will shift some from previous practices that were aimed toward our online attendees. I have developed some significant relationships with our online congregants and want to continue our care for that portion of our community of faith.
