Tuesday, September 19th 7pm. Purple Threads prayer and study group resumes.


Thursday, September 21st, 5:15pm. JUMP Kids midweek ministry for K-5th grade.

Thursday, September 21st, **6:30–7:30pm**. Thursday Evening Study resumes with *Dangerous Wonder*.


Purple Threads Women's Bible Study Fall Kick-Off




