We reviewed the lives of the twelve disciples of Jesus. I was pleased to have such a positive response to the idea that I was gifted two or three books about women of the Bible and also have in my possession two books on loan from one of our members. One book, written in 1955 is titled *All the Women of the Bible* by Edith Deen. There are many women in the Bible for which there is no background, and at times the name of the woman is not given but rather she is mentioned as the wife or daughter or mother of another person, usually a man.

It has been fun to put this series together and the dates, message titles and scriptures are found in this edition of the *Chimes*. There are eight messages in total, four women found in our Hebrew Scriptures and four women found in our New Testament. I want to thank Rev. Deb Cox for being a part of this message series. She will be preaching on July 14th while I am on vacation (and preaching) in Leeland, Michigan.

It is my prayer that we will enjoy this series of messages as much as last summer's and that we will deepen our appreciation for the *Women of the Bible*. I look forward to seeing you in worship!
