The church is exquisite and beautiful, with the main sanctuary flanked by several chapels, often built by rich and influential families. The churches were very impressive and the history of that Basilica alone would fill several volumes.

Gift Card Rebate Update

RaiseRight gift card sales for Central Church are paused and will resume in early October 2025 for holiday sales.

During 2024, Central Church earned \$633 in rebates from RaiseRight gift card sales. Thank you RaiseRight gift card supporters.

In the interim, you can still earn rebates for Central through RaiseRight.

- Gift cards (physical or e-cards) can still be purchased online or with the RaiseRight smartphone app. You just need to go to the RaiseRight.com website and set up an account associated with Waterford Central United Methodist Church.
- Physical gift cards can be purchased online or with the RaiseRight smartphone app and shipped to your home or directly to someone as a gift. There is a small shipping and handling fee. Shipping is via First Class Mail through the United States Postal Service.
- RaiseRight also recently added local dining to the RaiseRight smartphone app. For participating restaurants, when you pay using the RaiseRight app, Central Church earns a rebate. As one example (there are others), dining at Waterford restaurants, Square One Eats & Treats, Chicken Shack, CJ's Upper Deck, or AK's Burgers & Chicken, Central Church earns a 5% rebate.


