Blood Drives

Clothe-a-Child

This ministry provides clothing to children in Waterford. CUMC is in contact with social workers at Waterford elementary schools. When a child is recommended, all children in their family, from infant through high school, receive clothing. Toddlers and infants also receive diapers if requested. All are welcome to donate funds year round and/or help to organize clothing for delivery.

Food Pantry

Central runs a food pantry to help local families in need of meals. The program is administered by the church staff, but donations of food and/or funds are always needed and welcomed.

Outreach Ministries

C. W. Duncan Scholarships

Waterford Central UMC has provides scholarships for 12 boys and 12 girls annually. This mission is open to everyone to donate.

Good Samaritan Fund

Timing: Ongoing; Collection Taken Every Fifth Sunday

This ministry provides financial assistance to those in our community and surrounding areas. By helping people pay for rent or utilities, they can remain in their homes, providing a more stable

situation for individuals and families. This mission is open to everyone to donate. A collection is taken every fifth Sunday to support the Good Sam program, however you may donate at any time.

Ushers

Ushers assist people once they are in the building by helping them find seats, refreshments, the coat closet, Sunday school, the nursery, etc. Central has several usher teams that rotate through each month.

Liturgist

Serves: Approximately Once Every 2-3 Months

Liturgists work alongside the clergy on Sunday to deliver Bible readings. Anyone interested in delivering the word of God during worship is invited to become a Liturgist.
