# Dear Church Family,

Have you ever had a thought, an idea or even a premonition that captured your attention and stuck in your mind? Perhaps you gave the matter some further attention to search for any validity to your idea. I was recently at a meeting being facilitated by a leader who asked, "What is blocking us from achieving our goals?" My immediate thought was "paralyzing fear."

When I was about to share my thoughts, another person spoke, "fear and uncertainty." I thought, close enough, and later, as the conversation continued, I did mention the idea about paralysis.

That was this past Saturday, November 8, and yesterday, during our Consecration Sunday service, our speaker, Rev. Gary Step, began his message with lots of examples of why we live in fear and uncertainty. Pastor Gary went on to say that we can still define who we are as God's faithful people, even in the midst of

uncertainty. His challenge and call to us was to move! He wanted us to consider what it would look like for each of us to move forward in our support of our beloved Waterford Central United Methodist Church.

Pastor Gary then explained the Estimate of Giving Card and how we can express our moving forward in our support of next year's ministry. Those cards were then collected, collated and presented at our luncheon. I want to thank our Bookkeeper, Cassandra Thompson, who put all the information from our Estimate of Giving Cards together very efficiently, and there was reason to celebrate!

We received 78 Estimate of Giving Cards, of which 63 increased their commitment for next year's ministry. The total of all 78 cards is \$250,160. Combined with an estimate for those who have not filled out cards, income from non-donor sources (rentals, fees, interest) and loose offerings through the year, we can expect a total income for our general operating budget of \$467,831. That represents an increase of \$61,480, a 24% increase in total giving over this year's giving.

I want to thank everyone who attended our service on Sunday, stayed for lunch and gave us reason to hope for a great ministry and mission in 2026! Thank you to our dedicated Consecration Sunday Committee and all who made our Consecration Sunday a reason to celebrate! Blessings to you, my Church Family, and I will see you in worship!
