## Dear Central Church Family,

Just this morning, I was discussing with a parishioner what we might be giving up for Lent. While I have given up certain guilty pleasures for Lent (sweets, coffee, TV), I've found it more meaningful to add something to my Lenten schedule. One Lent, in an attempt to become more fit, I swam laps five days a week. Another Lent I read the four Gospels in a systematic way so that when we entered Holy Week, I was focusing on the Passion, Death, and Resurrection of Jesus.

I remember a young girl in a church where I was the youth pastor, giving up various pleasures in her life. First, she gave up chocolate, then pop, and finally chips. Each time she strayed from her plan, she picked another sacrifice to make. I finally intervened and suggested that she think about Lent as a process of making a sacrifice, which is the point of giving something up for Lent. The idea of giving something up for Lent reflects Christ's life of sacrificial giving to the point of dying on the cross, and it is for the length of time that Jesus was in the wilderness being tempted by Satan (40 days from Ash Wednesday to Easter, minus Sundays). I suggested to her that she stick with one thing and work on that one thing.

Whatever you do for Lent, I hope that you make a conscientious decision that will help you grow in your faith, deepening your relationship with God through Jesus the Christ. I pray you will lean on the Holy Spirit to guide you during this season for the purpose of becoming a more faithful follower of Christ.

I have four suggestions that I believe will help make your Lenten experience more meaningful. First, consider the sacrifice. Whether you are giving something up for Lent or adding something to your life throughout this period, count the cost. Giving something up may be more obvious in terms of sacrifice; however, adding something to your life is also a sacrifice of time and effort.

Second, keep at it! Consider Lent a process, and if you hit a bump, keep moving in the direction you want to go.

Third, whatever you do should make a lasting difference in your life. Ask yourself, "How will this experience make a difference in my life after Lent is over?" If what you've decided to do will not make a lasting difference, then evaluate why you want to do it.

Finally, ask for help. Build a support team to help achieve your goal. If you want to read more scripture, then ask someone to be an accountability partner. If you want to exercise more, get someone to do it with you!

I will cherish this final season of Lent with you, my Central Church family! I am looking forward to our Message Series, *Christ: Challenged*, and as our staff looks beyond Easter, I am already celebrating my time with you, as well as all my years as a pastor! As always, I hope to see you in worship!

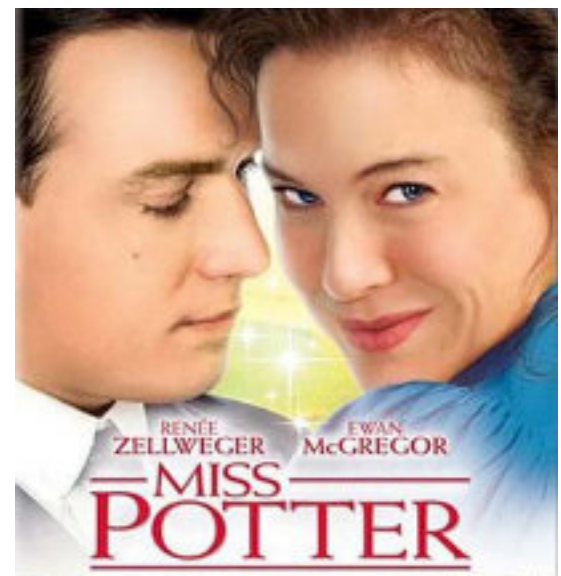
## A Call for Keepers of the Flame
